

The One Home Journey 2024-2030

- **WHAT:** A 7-year journey reaching out to every country on Earth:
- to support and connect Earth Citizens and their initiatives, across all borders to care for the Earth and for each other, and
- to draw on the cultural wealth, Indigenous wisdom and local innovations of all countries to jointly shape a future of planetary peace and wellbeing for all.
- **WHY**: Life on Earth is in danger.

Yet, everywhere, humanity is rising to claim Earth Citizenship and to take the journey from devastation and division to regeneration and unity. As Earth Citizens, we can tip the balance in favour of life.

- HOW: With Earth citizens worldwide, the One Home Journey initiates:
 - Homes for Humanity: honouring and championing innovative and courageous local initiatives that care inclusively for people, community and the Earth.
 - Unity Gardens for Peace with Nature and All Cultures: to experience and care for biological and cultural diversity, and the interconnectedness of all life.
 - Earth Citizens' Quests: Inter-generational, experiential, life-based 3-day learning journeys, and a Children's Quest to paint dreams and plant gardens (1/2 day).
 - The One Home UnivEARTHsity: co-creating as Earth Citizens a free, common platform for the collective learnings of the Journey, across all countries.
 - Transformative Public Performances, Films & Books: sharing the unfolding story of humanity's journey for our One Home Earth, and inspire action.
- WHAT WE FOUND: in Year 1, April 2024 to August 2025

The Co-Founders of Home for Humanity lived and worked "home to home", learning from and supporting diverse communities - from urban slums to Indigenous villages, refugee camps to ecovillages, universities to enterprises. Alongside the unique wisdom and innovations of each culture, most striking were

7 Findings in common, expressed widely across all 20 countries in Year 1:

- Care for the Earth: instinctive love and care for our one home, across all ages
- Belonging: "we are all connected" as a family of life on Earth
- Hospitality & Generosity: pride in welcoming strangers, gifting and sharing
- Healing: transcending trauma by ensuring "no one else suffers what I/we faced"
- Agency & Responsibility: taking initiative despite all odds, not awaiting help
- Co-creating: new initiatives of inclusion v/s fighting old divisive systems
- · All Humanity, all Life, and our One Earth are treasures to be cherished

IMPACT OF YEAR 1: 2024/2025 - across 20 countries in 4 world regions

- 40 new Homes for Humanity: local organisations recognised for their contributions.
- 26 Unity Gardens: planted in 20 countries, with over 7 000 participants
- 1415 in Inter-generational Earth Citizens Quests: 970 youth & 445 women
- 930 Children as Earth Citizens: painting, voicing and seeding future dreams
- Over 11 000 Earth Citizens: participated across all 20 countries

ENVISIONED IMPACT BY 2030 - across all countries on Earth

- 200 Homes for Humanity: one "lead" in every country "spreading the spark"
- 600 Unity Gardens: at least 3 Unity Gardens in every country
- 20 000 in Inter-generational Earth Citizens Quests: at least one per country
- 10 000 Children's Earth Citizens' Quests: at least one school per country
- One Million Earth Citizens reached: through all activities, plus performances, films and books
- One Home UnivEARTHsity: built up & freely available, uniting community (all Earth Citizens), campuses (all Homes for Humanity), and content (all countries)
