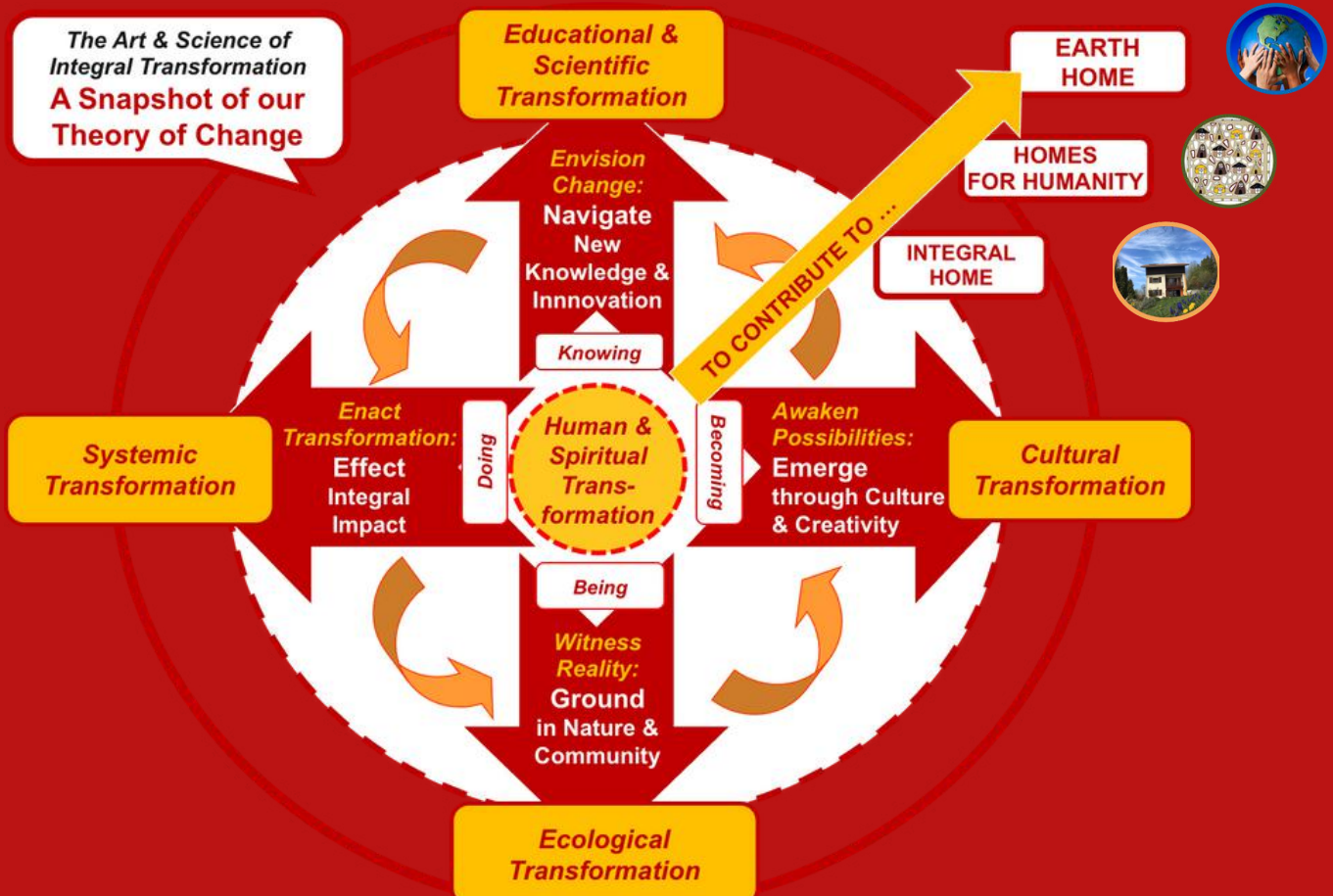

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 2020

## OVERVIEW

On 15 January 2020, Home for Humanity-l'Homme pour l'Humanité was registered as a non-profit association under French Association Law 1901 in the sous-prefecture of Belley in the French department of Ain. The Association builds on and converges the transcultural communities, integral approaches and educational and hands-on work of the co-founders/initiators and their collaborating changemakers worldwide over the past 16 years, through the TRANS4M Academy for Integral Transformation and the Theatre of Transformation Academy. Both Academies have by now become integrated building blocks within the Home for Humanity institution and movement.

2020, the first official year of operation of Home for Humanity as a consolidated legal entity, was significantly influenced by the unforeseen and unpredictable COVID-19 pandemic. The evolution of our programmes and strategic focus was both proactive and responsive to the way our partners worldwide were impacted in their grassroots and community-based operations, and how courageously, innovatively and humanely they rose to the challenge and became forerunners in the COVID response. For example, our partner Sarvodaya, Sri Lanka's leading community development organisation, became the home-based hub for the national response to COVID, based on its integral public health approach of 'Suvodaya': the wellbeing of all. Our Indian partner CORO and the Women's Federation of grassroots leaders from the slums of Mumbai innovated a humanely ingenious approach of 'no person and no home left behind'. These developments shaped the unfolding Home for Humanity story and our programme development.

As such unprecedented planetary crises become the norm, they exacerbate the homelessness of involuntary exile from home as well as dehumanising confinement within our homes, and inhumane systemic and societal responses to crises. In such times, our aspiration of finding effective ways of transforming our divided world into a 'home for humanity' for all life becomes ever more pressing.

The driving motivation in this foundational year of Home for Humanity was to uncover and disseminate widely, through our programmes and events, the power of 'humanity' and the metaphor of 'home'.

These are the cornerstones of the integral transformative approach that constitute our three-pronged strategic programme focus:

- the **inner home of our humanity**, recognising our intrinsic unity with all life,
- the **homes we live and work in**, which can become connected seedbeds for renewal
- our **Earth home**, which can now become the home for a collectively co-created Earth Civilization for all life.

The programme activities in 2020 served to articulate, disseminate and inspire global audiences for this new Home for Humanity Story for our times, in close collaboration with our longstanding partners worldwide, thus weaving a strengthened web of humanity, homes and cultures across our home planet to co-create an inclusive and regenerative future.





# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 2020

## HIGHLIGHTS

Despite the challenges COVID-19 posed to literally everyone, with particular consequences, of course, for non-profit associations, we are very pleased to report some extremely positive developments in our first year of existence as an association. We highlight here the following three developments.



### Visioneers International Network Award for Project Excellence

This award was given to Home for Humanity in 2020, honouring both the global impact of the integral work conducted over the past 13 years which laid the foundation for the new consolidated entity of Home for Humanity, as well as to express confidence in the vision, mission and intended contribution of Home for Humanity in this new phase.



*"This Visioneer Award recognizes and honours "Home for Humanity" for its magnificent contribution to a future of peace in our global diverse village. It models the sacredness of home as a central aspect of all peoples, it celebrates the colour, the art, the music, the poetry, the knowledge and wisdom traditions and cultural richness of this diversity that is a prime example of human nobility."*

### Earth Agora and Expansion of Major Global Supporters and Partners

The Earth Agora, addressed by Co-chairs Prof Jean Houston and Dr. Youssef Mahmoud, with over 50 of our closest partners and supporters, as well as our high level panels at online Global Summits and Conferences, led to a large expansion of the Home for Humanity network and outreach.

### Humanity Charter Film

A major contribution is an exquisite short film depicting the Humanity Charter in a captivating manner, produced *pro bono* by our co-founder Dr Eda Elif Tibet. Legendary South African Jazz musician Pops Mohammed, a friend and collaborator of Home for Humanity, gifted the uplifting soundtrack. The 4 minute film continues to inspire wherever it is screened!





# PROGRAMME 1 - INTEGRAL HOME - 2020

## OVERVIEW

Despite the restrictions of COVID, Home for Humanity delivered a number of successful short programmes on its Integral Home Campus – with a particular focus on piloting our flagship **Humanity Quest for integral Agents of Transformation**. In these pilot programmes, participants engaged practically with the Arts and Science of Integral Transformation, applied to their own life contexts and aspirations to contribute to societal transformation.

We developed a vision-programme-impact profile, kicked off the Living Curriculum with Global Pioneers and launched the engaging Home for Humanity Website. The consolidation of the lands of our Integral Campus, with the support of the local municipality of Haut Valromey, were further major achievements in this foundational year.

# PROGRAMME 2 - HOMES FOR HUMANITY - 2020

## OVERVIEW

In 2020, we laid a potent foundation for the Homes for Humanity story together with our longstanding co-creators from around the world, such as Sekem in Egypt, Sarvodaya in Sri Lanka, Pax Herbals in Nigeria, Sinal in Brazil, and Coro in India, among others. We moved towards building a planetary web of home-initiated agencies for integral transformation. From university courses, to global conferences to the creation of a "home-grown" Living Curriculum, together with pioneering partners from all continents, we raised awareness of the power of homes, and piloted the unfolding Homes for Humanity story.

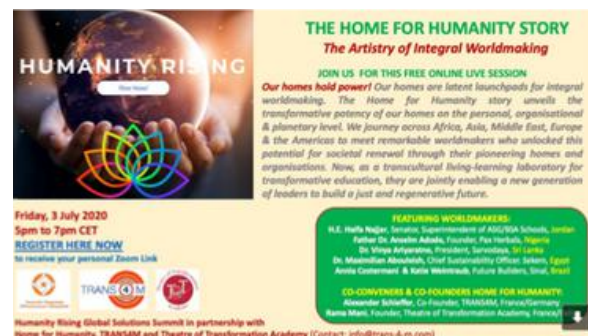

## OVERVIEW

The Earth Home Programme focuses on cultivating Humanity-in-Unity to practice Earth Citizenship and co-create an inclusive Earth Civilization.

The **Earth Agora** explores innovative formats of harvesting the wisdom of each of our cultures and the creativity of all humans to shape an inclusive Earth Civilization together.

The **Home for Humanity movie**, initiated in 2020, aspires to engage the wider public to co-author this emerging collective new story of humanity and homes uniting across borders for a regenerative future for all life.

Finally, "**Living Earth Artistry**" champions the power of art for human and planetary renewal. The preparatory visit of UNESCO Peace Artist and UN Goodwill Ambassador Marko Pogačnik in 2020 to create a Gaia Culture Art installation on the grounds of Home for Humanity, with the purpose of strengthening and disseminating our vision, constitute the best possible foundation for our future Living Earth Artistry activities.

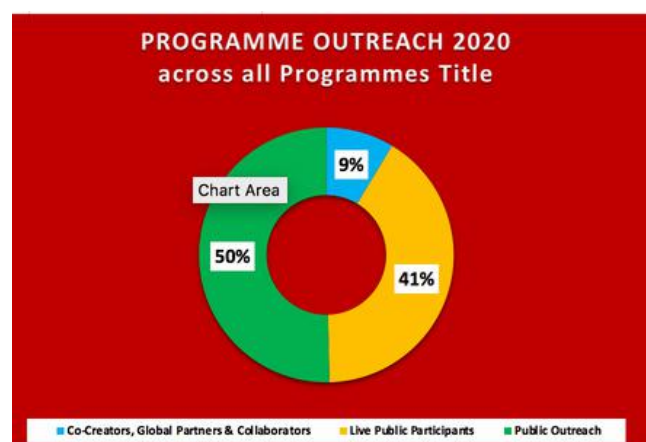

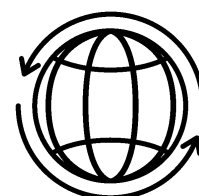

# FINANCIAL REPORTING 2020

## OVERVIEW

In our first year of operation, Home for Humanity managed to solicit already over € 12.000 of external funding – in addition to almost € 8.000 of financing support by its co-founders. Literally 99 percent of the cost were invested directly into the three programme streams, whereby 83 percent went into Programme Level 1 (Integral Home).

This was in line with the strategic orientation for 2020, as this programme level is foundational for the two other programme levels. The generous funding, the waiving from paying out any programme delivery fees in this initial phase, and the strong support through in kind contributions allowed Home for Humanity to conclude 2020 with a surplus of € 3.240.

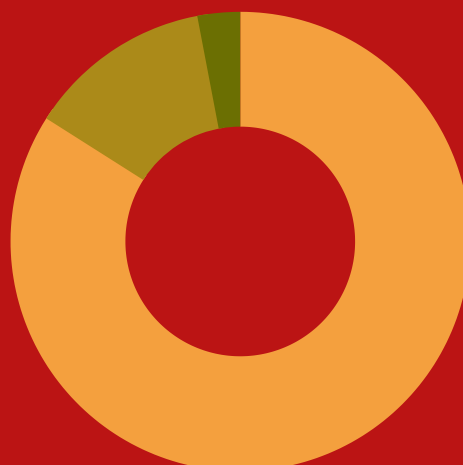

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 2021

## OVERVIEW

2021 was a year of turmoil for the world, as the volatility of COVID combined with environmental and political crises had a devastating impact on people, cultures and geographies. Home for Humanity and our Earth Family of pioneering partners responded humanely, holistically and innovatively to these challenges, and demonstrated the transformative power of humanity-in-unity in the face of global crisis and confusion.

To cite but few examples, in Zimbabwe, our partner, the Integral Kumusha (Shona for Homestead) emerged as the pioneering national role model for embodying the power of home in the face of economic, ecological and health crises. In India, our partner CORO was deeply affected by and responded magnificently to the devastating Delta wave. In Palestine our partners were severely affected by the hostilities, and Home for Humanity's collective solidarity was mobilised to support them. Since the Afghan debacle in August, as a natural response of humanity in unity, we have drawn on our global network of allies to actively support and mentor the families of our exiled Afghan collaborators and former students who were in the forefront of defending justice and women's rights and threatened by the Taliban.

Building on the foundational phase of 2020, Home for Humanity thus entered a phase of full-fledged activation in 2021, deploying each of its three strategic programme focus areas to both respond to global crises and to proactively activate human potential and the collective power of our homes and our cultures to shape a regenerative and inclusive future for all life.

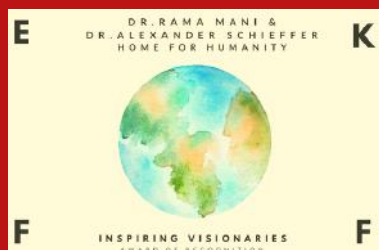
### Home for Humanity's first EARTH ARTISTS AWARD:

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 2021

## HIGHLIGHTS

The three major highlights we wish to emphasise in 2021 demonstrate the impact of our integral approach focused on activating the power of humanity, the power of homes, and the power of culture and creativity to respond transformatively to crises and co-create an inclusive and regenerative Earth Civilization for the family of life.



### Launch of our Living Curriculum Series

This YouTube series features over 25 of our pioneering and visionary collaborators across all continents, sectors, backgrounds and ages, interviewed in their own homes by young agents of transformation. The interviews showcase the power of their individual humanity, their homes and home organisations, and their cultural wisdom and creativity, and highlight their distinctive contributions towards the co-creation of an inclusive Earth Civilization. Launched on 23 January, the International Day of Education, and released weekly through July 2021, the series generated widespread interest and raised consciousness about how we all can be transformation agents, starting from our own lives and our own homes.



### Launch of Exemplary Homes for Humanity on all Continents

Throughout the year, eight of our long-standing integral partner organisations on all continents were launched as exemplary 'Homes for Humanity', honouring their pioneering contribution to ecological and societal regeneration over decades, which each of them continued to manifest amidst the crises of 2021. (Three of the launches of our exemplary partners which could not be scheduled in 2021 will follow in 2022.) These exemplars serve as the nucleus for a planetary 'Earth Campus' for Integral Education and Artistry for Earth Citizenship and Earth Civilization building. They also serve to inspire individuals worldwide to mobilise the power of their own homes and organisations to become launchpads for societal and ecological transformation.



### Launch of Earth Artistry, with a Gaia Culture Art Installation

Marko Pogačnik, UNESCO Peace Artist with six collaborating artists of the LIFENET art group from France, USA, Germany and Slovenia made a historic contribution to humanity and to France with their unique Gaia Culture art installation to support Home for Humanity's global vision, and heal humanity's relationship with nature, through their week-long artists' residency at the integral home campus.

# PROGRAMME 2 - HOMES FOR HUMANITY - 2021

## OVERVIEW

The major accomplishment was the launch of our pioneering partners and their organisations as exemplary pioneering 'Homes for Humanity' on all continents. Attracting large global audiences, the launches showcased the power of homes - ranging from family apartments, to shacks in marginalised urban slums, to home-initiated award winning enterprises – to be seedbeds for ecological and societal regeneration. Four more launches that could not be scheduled in 2021 will transpire in early 2022.



## PROGRAMME ACTIVITIES DELIVERED

### Transformative Education with "Homes for Humanity": Reshaping International Development Course

A Bachelor Course at the University of St. Gallen, Switzerland, hosted by Home for Humanity, in partnership with 5 exemplary Homes for Humanity, together developing an Integral Regenerative Resourcing framework adapted to the contexts of each partner organization across five continents.



### Integral PhD Module with Pioneering Partners in Jordan and Pioneers from Jordan, Zimbabwe, Nigeria and Egypt

A PhD Module with a Focus on Co-Creation, run by our TRANS4M Academy, to enable pioneering research-to-innovation processes - supporting the "Co-Creating Home on Earth" Vision - in partnership with Integral Enterprise pioneer MedLabs, Integral Education Pioneer Ahliyyah Mutran Schools, and Integral Economy Pioneer JoWomenomics, all from Jordan.



## Exemplary Homes for Humanity: Launches on all Continents throughout 2021

In total 8 launched in 2021, with 4 to be launched in early 2022. Each bears unique testimony to the power of homes to foster societal and ecological transformation. They range from small family apartments to paradigm shifting organisations that started off in a home.







# ZOOMING IN: HOMES FOR HUMANITY 2021

## Homes for Humanity - Emerging All Over the World

**All our homes have the potential to become launchpads for human and global transformation. Here are pioneers of the power of homes across our shared Earth home...**

Throughout 2021, Home for Humanity launched eight exemplary Homes for Humanity in the Middle East, Asia, Africa and Latin America. Together, we aim to develop a “home grown” pathway to regenerate and connect our Earth Community around our home planet. With each one addressing, in a holistic manner, burning issues in its own community and society, together we connect across continents, transcend borders and ideologies, to jointly lay the foundation for a just, inclusive and regenerative Earth Civilization.



### Home for Humanity Jerusalem, Palestine

#### Focus: Social Justice and Women Power

*Showcases the power of a single family home to initiate and sustain societal transformation amidst conflict over 5 decades. The family home of Zahira Kamal has nurtured the birth and growth of the earliest and strongest women's organisations of Palestine. Uniquely, this family home has supported transformative movements that span grassroots, women's and political activism and cut across non-governmental, governmental, and intergovernmental sectors, as well as business and arts, aiming for non-violent, humane ways to forge the path to peace, freedom and women's leadership.*



### Sinal do Vale, Mata Atlantica, Brazil

#### Focus: Regeneration, Reforestation, Food Security

*SINAL was created in 2011 by eminent environmental and women's leader Thais Corral. Starting with a single farmhouse, it is a center for the regeneration of ecosystems, communities, and individuals. It stewards 200 hectares of land between Rio de Janeiro and the Mata Atlantica Forest. SINAL, an acronym for synchronicity, innovation and joy, is a School for Transformation Agents of all countries and backgrounds to live and learn sustainability with and from nature. It also supports the local community and educates local children and youth in sustainability.*



### Integral Kumusha, Buhera, Zimbabwe

#### Focus: Integral Homestead & Regenerative Community Economics ('Nakanomics')

*Hosted by Dr. Daud & Christina Taranhike (respectively Chairman and CEO of LionKing), in Daud's childhood homestead, Integral Kumusha emerged from Daud's PhD with TRANS4M. Rooted in local Shona & Ubuntu values of interdependence, care and compassion, this "kumusha" (home) supports impoverished homesteads and local communities to create sustainable livelihoods. It has won national acclaim as an exemplar of a Sustainable Village economy, and is currently being scaled up across the country.*



### CORO & Women's Federation, India

#### Focus: Grassroots Women's Leadership

*Mumtaz Shaikh and Rahul Gaware's home represents the thousands of homes of grassroots leaders of the Women's Federation (Savitri Mahila Mandal) in low-income 'slums' of Mumbai. Supported by CORO, an Indian NGO, for over 30 years, women facing domestic violence, destitution and powerlessness tapped their 'power within, power with and power to' become community leaders, reshape local, regional and national government legislation, and even win elections, and now are creating a Grassroots Leadership Academy. Mumtaz was one of BBC's 100 outstanding women in 2015.*





# ZOOMING IN: HOMES FOR HUMANITY 2021



## SEKEM Enterprises, Egypt

**Focus: Greening the Desert, Integral Human Development, Economics of Love**

*Founded in 1977, by the family of Dr. Ibrahim Abouleish, Sekem grew from a single home in a barren desert to an oasis of biodynamic agroecology with a large multi-cultural community of sustainable farmers, businesses, health clinics, and non-profit societies. It champions lifelong education through nursery, primary, vocational, disabled schools and Heliopolis University, Egypt's first for Sustainable Development. It has received the Alternative Nobel Prize and the Business for Peace Award.*



## Pax Herbals Clinic & Laboratory, Nigeria

**Focus: Traditional African Medicine, Integral Healing, Indigenous Knowledge, & 'Communitarism'**

*Nigeria's foremost natural, herbal medicine and holistic healing provider. Founded in a Benedictine Monastery in Ewu in 1994 by monk Dr. Anselm Adodo, through whose PhD with TRANS4M it became an integral enterprise-in-community, based on 'communitarism' or community-based economics. It taps into the ecological, cultural, educational, technological, economic, and spiritual GENE-ius of Nigeria and Africa, and champions indigenous knowledge creation and preservation.*



## 'Come to My Home', Morocco

**Focus: Cultural Renewal and Social Co-Existence through the the unifying power of the Arts**

*Driss Alaoui Mdaghri opened his family home in Casablanca to host the 'Come to my Home' festival, where artists, poets, musicians, scholars and changemakers of all social and cultural backgrounds meet to transform society through the power of art. Driss was formerly a cabinet minister, professor of economics, director of business schools, as well as visual artist and poet. His home and the Come to my Home festival, which has spread to many countries, exemplify the cultural power of homes.*



## Home for Humanity Garden, Switzerland

**Focus: Inclusion and Eco-Cultural Regeneration**

*Demonstrates that even a modest urban communal garden can foster social inclusion, cultural creativity and biodiversity.*

*Hosted by Cihan Elci, a Kurdish refugee and former cultural activist for freedom, and Dr. Elif Tibet, an award winning film maker, this garden has been transformed into a space for healing trauma and cultivating inclusion through nature and the arts.*



## Further Launches Ahead

*2021 was too short to launch four of our exemplary Homes for Humanity: they will be launched in early 2022.*

- **Sarvodaya, Sri Lanka:** the largest and oldest integral community development organisation in the country
- **Terra Meera, Croatia:** an innovative new regeneration and sustainability educational community

- **Eriksen Institute Denmark:** a holographic, well-being approach to self-organisational transformation.

# PROGRAMME 3 - EARTH HOME - 2021

## OVERVIEW

In 2021, we evolved the Earth Agora's creative methodology through several participatory events. We pioneered Earth Artistry and launched the Residency and Award, with the Gaia Culture art installation led by Marko Pogačnik, UNESCO Peace Artist. Filming for the Home for Humanity movie accompanied all events in 2021. A final high note: five songs inspired by the Humanity Charter were gifted to Home for Humanity by talented young musicians, including by refugee activist Enzo Ikah from DR Congo.

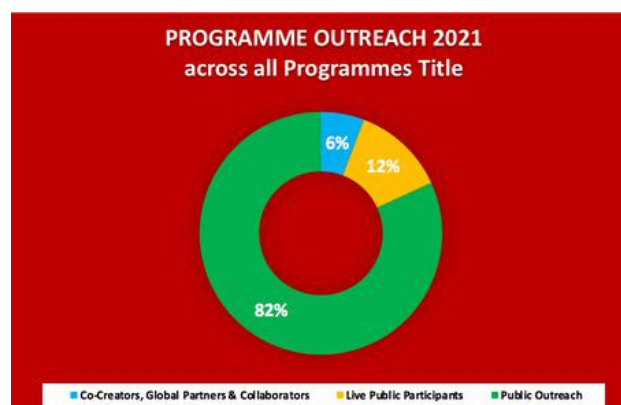

## QUANTITATIVE IMPACT EVALUATION & PROGRAMME OUTREACH

In 2021, we reached 6160 people in total through our programme activities around the world, up from 1458 in 2020. This includes our co-creators and collaborators, live participants and students in programme activities, and public audiences eg viewing our youtube channel recordings subsequently. ## GLOBAL OUTREACH

In 2021, we held programme activities with our co-creators and Homes for Humanity in (12) countries: Egypt, Palestine, Brazil, Zimbabwe, Nigeria, Morocco, India, Sri Lanka, Jordan, Croatia, Switzerland and France. Participants in our programmes came from at least 40 countries on all continents. At Home for Humanity's Integral Home Campus alone, we hosted about 200 co-creators and participants from 35 countries in our on-site programme activities.

In our second year of operation, Home for Humanity managed to deliver its many programmes and events again on a comparably very low cost base - due to the high level of voluntary work received. We are proud to share that we were able to almost double the external funding, as compared to 2020, also with a more diverse funder base. Part of the funding secured has even been promised over a three-year period, with the clear aim to build up our fundraising strength and programme development support.

As the major donations were only received late in the year, the two co-founders/initiators of Home for Humanity have financed a significant part of the expenses of 2021. However, the donations not only lead to a surplus in 2021, but put us in a good "starting position" for 2022.

## CONTRIBUTIONS IN KIND

While voluntary contributions had already been very generous in 2020, 2021 saw yet another rise in both generic contributions in kind, and cultural and artistic contributions. Based on extremely conservative rates, we calculated the total of non-monetary contributions to be over EURO 205.000, an increase of 35% compared to 2020.

The percentage of cultural-artistic contributions, compared to the previous year rose from 20 to 26 percent. We clearly noticed that the Home for Humanity work and vision strongly inspires artists, in particular also young artists, to contribute - and to give creative expression to the regenerative and inclusive future we are jointly aspiring to build.

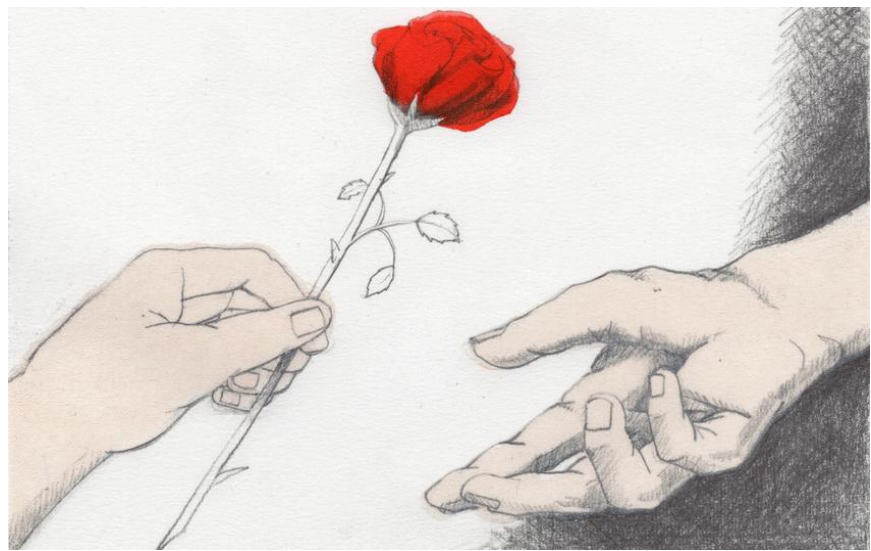

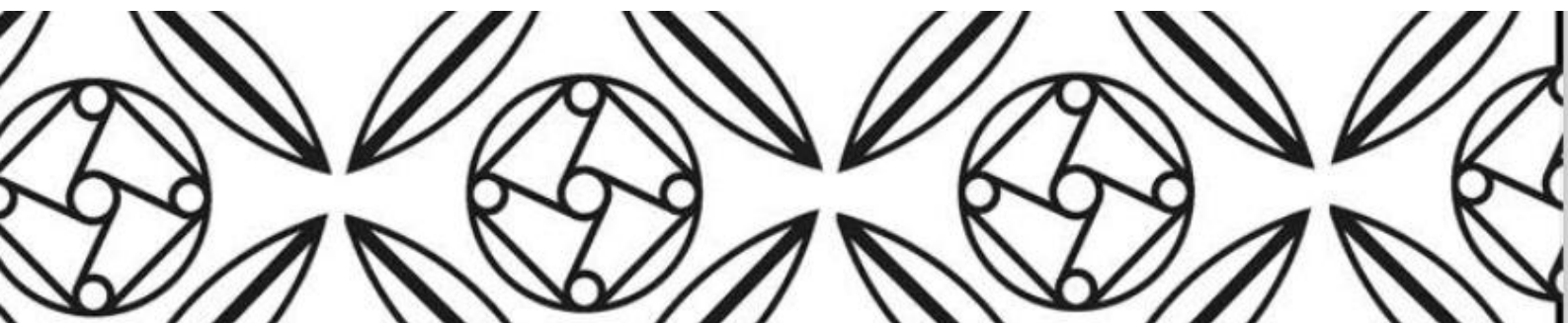
