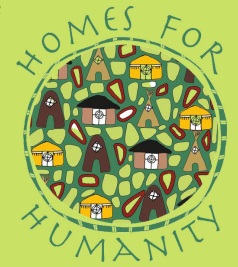

This impact oriented model of transformative education and integral leadership is now offered in a compact format to a global public audience to enable individuals and organizations from diverse backgrounds to become agents of transformation and to work towards co-creating a just and a regenerative future for all living beings.

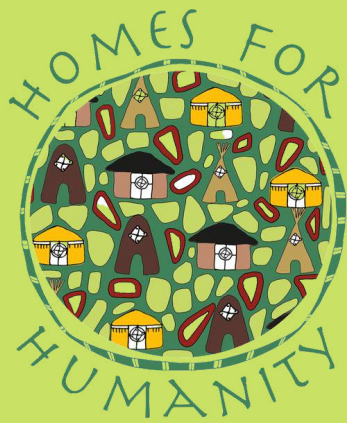
